

OSU Figure Skating Club Membership Form September 2009 – June 2010

OSU Figure Skating Club (OSU FSC) is a student organization that promotes the sport of figure skating. Membership is open to skaters of all levels and disciplines within the realm of figure skating. All members must be students, faculty, staff, or alumni of The Ohio State University (this includes post-secondary, part-time, full-time and graduate students). Each member is required to have current USFS membership in addition to current OSU FSC membership. Skaters can submit USFS membership through the OSU FSC or their home clubs.

All OSU FSC members are required to maintain current recreational sports status through the Recreational Sports Department at OSU. This includes, but may not be limited to, online registration, entering and updating personal contact information, filling out insurance forms, and completing alcohol training by their respective deadlines. Failure to comply with the aforementioned requirements may result in suspension or dismissal from the club.

Membership in the club allows skaters to utilize OSU FSC ice time (times vary each quarter). Only those who are members of OSUFSC and the USFS may skate on club ice time.

The officers of the OSUFSC reserve the right to adjust the ice time during the quarter for either safety or financial reasons.

To be a member-in-good-standing, the skater must pay all fees ON TIME. All ice fees must be paid before the member may skate. Money collected is paid to the order of the OSU FSC. A late fee WILL be assessed for any paperwork and/or fees that are collected after the deadline. Deadlines are set by the Club President each quarter and announced to the club via email and the first club meeting of the quarter. All fees are non-refundable. If a skater who is not a member-in-good-standing takes to the ice, the OSU FSC reserves the right to suspend or revoke the skater's membership.

Further, skaters shall follow the general rules of conduct while on the ice. Right-of-way is given to any skater in a program. Members will not intentionally interfere with another skater's progress in any way. Accidents can and do happen, but members shall not intentionally cause them. Purposeful, continued interference, after warning and other appropriate measures by the club officers, is grounds for revocation of club membership.

Membership for the 2009-2010 academic year is \$15.00. Membership must be paid in full before members can participate in club ice.
